Global Study Lounge Frequently Asked Questions

1. Do I need to book to go to the Global Study Lounge?

No, you do not need to book the lounge in order to use it. It is open for all students Monday – Friday; 08:00 – 21:00 during the semester and 08:00 – 18:00 during vacation periods.

2. How do I get into the Global Study Lounge?

It is in the Edith Morley Building on the second floor in room 230. During its opening hours, the door is unlocked and can be opened by pushing firmly.

3. Do I need to register to attend Global Study Lounge events?

No, Global Study Lounge events do not require registration unless stated they do. They are free to attend, you just need to turn up on the correct day and time!

4. How do I book the study pods in the Global Study Lounge?

Students can book the study pods for a maximum of 6-8 students depending on the pod for up to 2 hours by emailing <u>isli-admin@reading.ac.uk</u>. You're welcome to use the pods if they are free, but please check the timetables in the Lounge by the entrance.
